- Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF):** Rs. 17,500 for candidates with the category tag SC, ST, GEN-PwD, GEN-EWS-PwD, OBC-NCL-PwD, SC-PwD or ST-PwD and Rs. 35,000 for all other candidates (the fee includes Rs. 5,000 JoSAA processing charges). *The seat acceptance fee, excluding JoSAA processing charges of Rs. 5000, will be adjusted against the admission fee.*
- Partial Admission Fee (PAF):** At the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> round of JoSAA 2024, candidates having a provisionally allocated seat (allocated in any round of JoSAA 2024 and which has not been canceled or withdrawn) are required to pay the **Partial Admission Fee (PAF)** in addition to the **Seat Acceptance Fees (SAF)** from their JoSAA portal.

**Non-payment** of the partial admission fee will be treated as a **rejection of the offered/allocated seat**. Candidates are thus strongly advised to be vigilant and make the payment well within the stipulated time.

**Partial Admission Fee (PAF) is Rs. 20,000** for candidates with the category tag SC, ST, GEN- PwD, GEN-EWS-PwD, OBC-NCL-PwD, SC-PwD or ST-PwD, and **Rs. 45,000** for all other candidates. The partial admission fee will be adjusted against the Institute admission fee.

- The JoSAA will remit the total collected amount from a candidate (**after deducting the non-refundable processing charges of Rs. 5,000/-**)  
**Rs. 12,500 + 20,000 = 32,500** (for SC, ST, and PwD Candidates)  
**Rs. 30,000 + 45,000 = 75,000** (for all other Candidates) to the Institute (IIIT Raichur) where the candidate is finally admitted.
- After paying the partial admission fee on the JoSAA portal, the candidates who are **not participating in CSAB Special rounds** should complete the Institute Registration Process of IIIT Raichur as detailed in **Points 05 – 09** below (**Table I**).
- Candidates who got provisional admission at IIIT Raichur (through JoSAA/CSAB-2024) are required to pay the balance Institute fees.

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### **1. Meaning of Ragging**

In common parlance, ragging means playing practical jokes on somebody or teaching someone a lesson.

The Supreme Court of India perhaps has given a more comprehensive meaning of ragging as under: Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

I have read the above basic definition of the Supreme Court of India and understood the meaning of the same. By signing here, I agree not to participate in any ragging activities during my stay here at IIT Raichur.

Hon'ble Supreme Court**

2. **Brief Overview of Observations of the Supreme Court of India**

***(Case: The University of Kerala vs The Council of Principals of College in Kerala & Others)***

- A. Ragging in educational institutions has been a matter of concern for this Court since long. Noticing that, notwithstanding a judgment of this Court in Vishwa Jagriti Mission through President vs Central Government through Cabinet Secretary & others (AIR 2001SC 2793), few remedial practical measures have been taken to prevent the menace of ragging in educational institutions.
- B. Ragging is rationalized and justified as a way of *Introduction* or *Getting Familiar* with the freshers at the starting of an academic session of any educational institution.
- C. In a very positive aspect, "Ragging" could not be considered as an abridgement between the seniors and the freshers, whereas "Introduction" could be considered as genesis of relationship between the two.
- D. When any student is admitted in a particular institution, he/she has to face certain problems and one of them which affects them the most is staying away from home and especially away from the dear ones. Because of these problems, the freshers expect someone to look after them, with whom they can have a homely environment as they were enjoying themselves at their respective homes. But nowadays the seniors have crossed the barriers, by which they have changed the meaning of "Introduction" into "Ragging".
- E. "Seniors" under the garb of "Introduction" have started ragging the fresher's and due to which, in recent years, it has become the talk of the day that the fresher's who have faced severe ragging are leaving the educational institutions, and some have attempted to commit suicide and even some have committed it.
- F. In modern era, "Ragging" has become \*to be known only as synonym of "teasing", "terror", "harassment", "cruelty", "fear" and "physical and mental torture".
- G. By perusal of records and survey, it has come to be accepted that "Ragging" is a systematized form of Human Rights' abuse as embodied under the Constitution of India as well as other Constitutions of the World.
- H. Over the years all over the world and especially in South Asia, the practice of "Ragging" has come to be meant as an extreme "harassment", "terror" and even "physical and mental torture" of freshers.
- I. Ragging is a set of undisciplined activities undertaken by the seniors to break the ice with the juniors, who have been suddenly thrown into a totally new environment. The contention of seniors behind all such activities is simply to bring the freshers down to earth, because in their opinion the freshers do not respect the seniors and by doing all such inhuman activities under the garb of "Introduction", the seniors rag the freshers so that the freshers may respect them and be under their control. But this act cannot *be* reasonable and just. The act by the seniors is a "fist of steel against ice" and likewise by doing so, they shatter the ambition, aim and object of freshers and they become aloof in this practical world.

**2023-Undertaking by Student of IIIT Raichur and his/her Parent on Ragging at IIIT Raichur**

J. To prohibit "Ragging", this Court has given a series of guidelines to the educational institutions whether being Central, State, or private institutes.

Anti-ragging movement should be initiated by the institutions right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately which punishment may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or class for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take the shape of:

- (i) Withholding scholarships or other benefits
- (ii) Debarring from representation in events
- (iii) Withholding results and
- (iv) Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess, and the like.

If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in the Statutes and Ordinances, they should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions.

The application form for admission/enrolment shall have a printed undertaking to be filled up and signed by the candidate to the effect that he/she is aware of the institution's approach towards ragging and the punishments to which he or she shall be liable if found guilty of ragging. A similar undertaking shall be obtained from the parent/guardian of the applicant.

Such institutions as introducing such a system for the first time shall ensure undertakings being obtained from the students and their parents/guardians already studying in the institutions before the commencement of the next educational year/session.

4. That I have not been found or charged for my involvement in any kind of ragging in the past. However, I undertake to face disciplinary action / legal proceedings including expulsion from the institute if the above statement is found to be untrue or the facts are concealed, at any stage in future.
5. I understand that as per the rules and resolution of the Institute, I will not be permitted to possess or use any motorized vehicle inside the Institute campus, unless I am permitted to do so by a written authorization from the Competent Authority.
6. I also declare that I am not suffering from any serious contagious ailment including psychology related symptoms.
7. I under take that I will not indulge in any behavior or act that may be constituted as Sexual Harassment, I will not participate in or abet or propagate through any act of commission or omission that may be constituted as Sexual Harassment and if found guilty of Sexual Harassment, I am liable for punishment, without prejudice to any other criminal action that may be taken against me under any penal law or any law for the time being in force.

**Code of Conduct and Discipline:**

1. Students shall conduct themselves within and outside the precincts of the Institute in a manner befitting the students of an institution of national importance. Students should maintain

- decency and decorum throughout their course of study in the Institute.
2. Students shall show due respect to the Faculty of the Institute, the Wardens of the Hostels, the Sports Officers, Staff, etc., proper courtesy and consideration should be extended to the employees of the Institute and of the Hostels. They shall also pay due attention and courtesy to visitors.
  3. Students are required to develop a friendly relationship with fellow students. In particular, they are expected to show kindness and consideration to the new students admitted to the Institute every year. Law bans ragging in any form to anybody - acts of ragging will be considered as gross indiscipline and will be severely dealt with.
  4. The following acts of omission and/or commission shall constitute gross violation of the code of conduct and are liable to invoke disciplinary measures:
    - i. Ragging
    - ii. Furnishing false statement of any kind in the form of application for admission or for award of scholarship etc.,
    - iii. Displaying lack of courtesy and decorum; resorting to indecent behavior anywhere within or outside the campus.
    - iv. *Willfully damaging or stealthily removing any property/belongings of the Institute /*
    - v. *construction site / fellow students.*
    - vi. Possession, consumption or distribution of alcoholic drinks or any kind of hallucinogenic drugs.
    - vii. Adoption of unfair means in the examinations.
    - viii. Organizing or participating in any group activity in company with others in or outside the campus without prior permission of the Competent Authority.
    - ix. Mutilation or unauthorized possession of library books.
    - x. Resorting to noisy and unseemly behavior, disturbing studies of fellow students.
    - xi. Misuse of Internet / e-mail facilities or tempering/ hacking with servers anywhere in the Hostels / Departments etc.,
    - xii. Not intimating of absence to the authority of hostel before availing any leave

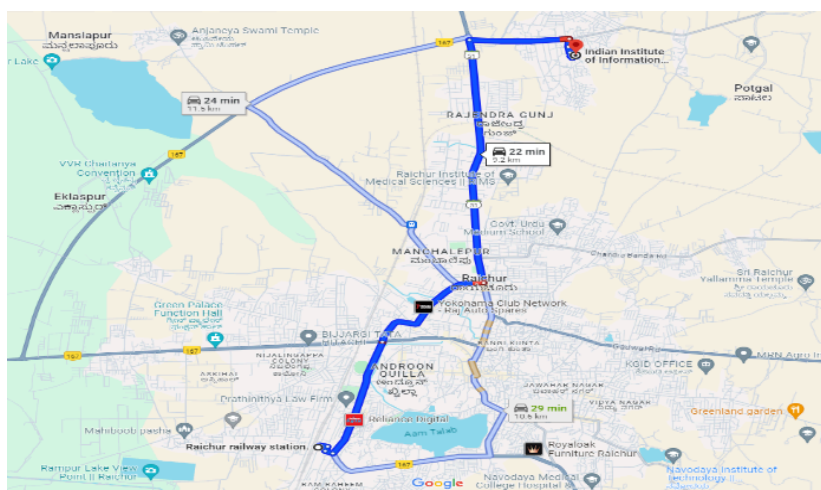
